

PRIDE EVENTS IN NEW YORK CITY

SUNDAY, JUNE 6 – QUEENS PRIDE Jackson Heights, Queens

Queens Pride Festival is from 12:00 pm to 6:00 pm on 37th Road. Subway trains are: E, F, G or R train to Roosevelt Avenue, walk one block to 37th Road.

Queens Pride Parade starts at 12:00 pm. The route moves down 37th Avenue to 75th Street, then over to 37th Road. Subway trains are: E, F, G or R train to Roosevelt Avenue, walk upstairs and take the 7 train to 90th Street. Exit train and walk to 89th Street and 37th Avenue.

Line-up time for GMHC contingent is 11:30 am at 89th Street, near 37th Avenue. Look for the GMHC banner and people in GMHC teeshirts. Or ask a parade marshal at the Registration Table at the northeast corner of 89th Street and 37th Avenue.

SATURDAY, JUNE 12 – BROOKLYN PRIDE Park Slope, Brooklyn

Brooklyn Pride Festival is from 11:00 am to 6:00 pm on Prospect Park West (between 9th and 15th Streets). Subway train is: F train to 7th Avenue/Park Slope OR 15th Street/Prospect Park.

Brooklyn Parade starts at 9:00 pm. The route starts on Prospect Park West and 15th Street. Then moves a few blocks on 15th Street to 7th Avenue, makes a right. Then the route goes east on 7th Avenue to Lincoln Place.

Line-up Time for GMHC contingent is 8:30 pm on Prospect Park West between 14th and 13th Streets. Look for GMHC banner and people in GMHC teeshirts. Or ask a parade marshal at the Registration Table near the entrance to Prospect Park.

SATURDAY, JUNE 12 – BRONX PRIDE HEALTH DAY – Montefiore Medical Center, The Bronx

Bronx Pride Health Day is from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm on Montefiore and Gun Hill Road (between Bainbridge Avenue and Dekalb Avenue). Subway trains are: **#4 train** to Mosholu Parkway Station. Walk north on Jerome Avenue and turn right on 208th Street. At the fork, follow 210th Street to Bainbridge Avenue, cross the street and

turn left. OR **D train** to 205th Street Station (last stop). Street sign says 206th Street and Bainbridge. Walk north on Bainbridge Avenue.

FRIDAY, JUNE 25 – BLACK PRIDE NYC VERIZON YOUTH AGENDA & HEALTH FAIR – Riverbank State Park, NYC

Black Pride NYC Youth Health Fair is from 1:00 pm to 9:00 pm at the Riverbank State Park (145th Street and the Westside Highway). Subway train is: #9 (skip service) to 145th Street. Walk one block west.

SATURDAY, JUNE 26 – BLACK PRIDE NYC CULTURAL CELEBRATION & HEALTH FAIR – Riis Beach, Far Rockaway, Queens

The Black Pride NYC Cultural Celebration & Health Fair is from 12:00 pm to 8:00 pm at Riis Beach. Subway trains and bus are: #2 or 5 to Flatbush Avenue. Take Q35 bus to Riis Beach.

SUNDAY, JUNE 27 – NYC PRIDE FESTIVAL & MARCH - Manhattan

NYC Pride Festival is from 11:30 am to 10:30 pm on Washington Street between Christopher and Spring Streets. Subway trains are: #1 or 9 train to Christopher Street, then walk west to Washington, make a left.

NYC Pride March starts at 12:00 pm. The route moves down 5th Avenue to West 8th Street, then heads west to Christopher Street and ends at Greenwich Street. Subway train is: F train to 57th Street and 6th Avenue. Walk to 56th Street and make a left, walk towards 5th Avenue. These are directions for the start of the march. Any train on the 6th Avenue line connects with the march along its route.

At 2:00 pm throughout the march, there is the annual Moment of Silence in memory of those we have lost to AIDS.

Line-up time for GMHC contingent is 11:30 am on 56th Street between 5th and 6th Avenues. Look for the GMHC banners, and people in GMHC teeshirts.

SATURDAY, JUNE 26 – DYKE MARCH

DYKE March starts at 5:00 pm at Bryant Park, Sixth Avenue at 42nd Street. Line-up time is 4:30 pm. The March route is south on Fifth Avenue to Washington Square Park (one block south of East 8th Street).

SATURDAY, JULY 10 – YOUTH PRIDE - Riverbank State Park, NYC

Youth Pride is from 12:00 pm to 7:00 pm at the Riverbank State Park (145th Street and the Westside Highway). Subway train is: #9 (skip service) to 145th Street. Walk one block west.

SATURDAY, AUGUST 7 – PRIDE IN THE CITY FAMILY DAY IN THE PARK – Ft. Greene Park, Fort Greene, Brooklyn

Pride in the City Family Day in the Park is from 11:00 am to 7:00 pm in Ft. Greene Park (DeKalb Avenue and Washington Park). Subway trains is: #B, Q, R to DeKalb Avenue, walk east 7 blocks to Ft. Greene Park. OR C train to Lafayette Avenue, walk north two blocks on South Oxford Street to DeKalb Avenue, make a right, walk two blocks to entrance to Ft. Greene Park.

SUNDAY, AUGUST 8 –PRIDE IN THE CITY BEACH PARTY – Riis Beach, Far Rockaway, Queens

Pride in the City Beach Party is from 12:00 pm to 8:00 pm at Riis Beach. Subway trains and bus are: #2 or 5 to Flatbush Avenue. Take Q35 bus to Riis Beach.

WAYS TO VOLUNTEER, PARTICIPATE and CELEBRATE WITH GMHC

GMHC's volunteers, clients, board members, staff (and loved ones) will be participating in the Pride events throughout the summer. There are various ways you can help during these events. Whether you are making posters, helping at a GMHC table (distributing materials, etc.) during an event, or walking in a parade or march with the GMHC contingent, most volunteer shifts are approximately **four hours** (not including travel time to/from event).

Here are the opportunities:

- Assisting with poster-making prior to parades/march
- Marching during a parade/march
 - Carrying/not carrying a poster
 - Handing out materials along route
 - Riding on a float
- Supervising contingent during a parade/march (Marshal)
 - Helping to keep contingent together—not separated by traffic lights, etc.
 - Distributing bottled water and posters
 - Dispatching instructions from committee members along route and police
- Tabling during a festival/health fair for a shift
 - Set-up/clean-up of booth
 - Distributing materials
 - Talking with general public about GMHC services
- Supervising tablers during a shift at a festival/health fair
 - Overseeing set-up/clean-up of booth
 - Working with volunteers and staff
